

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

to the

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

DUPONT CIRCLE CITIZENS ASSOCIATION

To: The Recorder of Deeds, D.C.

Pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act, the undersigned adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Dupont Circle Citizens Association.

SECOND: The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the Corporation in the manner prescribed by the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act:

Delete the entire THIRD Article of the Articles of Incorporation and substitute therefore the following THIRD Article:

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is to promote and protect the interests of the District of Columbia, and particularly those in the Dupont Circle area of said District of Columbia, said Dupont Circle area having the following boundaries including properties on both sides of the following streets, except where indicated: on the East, the west side of 15th Street from -K- Street to Florida Avenue; on the North, on Florida Avenue west from 15th Street to -S- Street and on -S- Street to Massachusetts Avenue; on the West, on Massachusetts Avenue south from -S- Street to Rock Creek and following the east side of said Creek to -K- Street; and on the South, on -K- Street east from Rock Creek to the east side of 15th Street.

Among the Association's general purposes, but not limited thereto, are to carry out charitable and educational activities and to work for civil and social improvements in said Dupont Circle area and the District of Columbia; to promote historical preservation and to preserve the historic, architectural and aesthetic value of property and objects in said Dupont Circle area and the District of Columbia; to present the views of its members to government, public, private and other organizations; to engage

In any lawful activity and to take legal action to protect the interests of its members and the residents, home-owners, and property-owners in said Dupont Circle area and the District of Columbia.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation pursuant to the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Dupont Circle Citizens Association.

SECOND: The period of duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is to promote and protect the interests of the District of Columbia, and particularly those in the Dupont Circle area of said District of Columbia, said area having the following boundaries including properties on both sides of the following streets, except where indicated: on the East, the west side of 15th Street from -K- Street to Florida Avenue; on the North, on Florida Avenue west from 15th Street to -S- Street and on -S- Street to Massachusetts Avenue; on the West, on Massachusetts Avenue south from -S- Street to Rock Creek and following the east side of said Creek to -K- Street; and on the South, on -K- Street east from Rock Creek to the east side of 15th Street.

Among the Association's general purposes, but not limited thereto, are to carry out charitable and educational activities; work for civil and social improvements in said area;

The designation of each class of members, the qualifications and rights of the members of each class and conferring, limiting, or denying the right to vote are fully set forth in the By-laws.

SIXTH: The manner of election and/or appointment of the Directors of the corporation is as provided in the By-laws.

SEVENTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are fully set forth in the By-laws.



ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
to the
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the
DUPONT CIRCLE CITIZENS ASSOCIATION

To: The Recorder of Deeds
Washington, D.C.

The undersigned Dupont Circle Citizens Association hereby adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Organization.

FIRST: Article II is amended by adding immediately at the end thereof the following:

"The Association is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax law."

SECOND: The Articles of Organization are further amended by adding at the end thereof the following new Article VIII and Article IX.

ARTICLE VIII

Section 1. No part of the net earnings of the Association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the Association shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes.

Section 2. No substantial part of the activities of the Association shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Association shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation or organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax law) or (b) by a corporation or organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax law).

ARTICLE IX

DISSOLUTION

Section 1. Upon dissolution of the Association, the Executive Committee of said Association, acting as its board of directors, shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Association, dispose of all of the assets of the Association exclusively for the purposes of the Association in such manner, or to such organizations organization(s) organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as at the time shall qualify as an exempt organization(s) under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding

provisions of any federal tax law), as the Executive Committee shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of competent jurisdiction in the District of Columbia, where the principal office of the Association is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s) as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Section 2. If, however, the recipient named by the Executive Committee is not then in existence or no longer is a qualified distributee, or unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets of this Association shall be distributed to a fund, foundation or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law).

THIRD: These amendments were adopted by a two-thirds vote of the membership of the Association at a special meeting of the members held on 30 June 1986, which was convened for the purpose of considering these amendments.

" . . . said area having the following boundaries including properties on both sides of the following streets, except where indicated: from the intersection of K Street and the west side of 15th Street, northerly along the west side of 15th Street to the north side of S Street; thence easterly along the north side of S Street to the west side of 14th Street; thence northerly along the west side of 14th Street to the south side of U Street; thence westerly along the south side of U Street to the west side of 15th Street; thence northerly along the west side of 15th Street to Florida Avenue, N.W.; thence westerly along Florida Avenue to S Street; thence westerly on S Street to Massachusetts Avenue; thence southerly from the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and S Street to Rock Creek; thence southerly (downstream) along the east side of said Creek to K Street; thence easterly along K Street to the east side of 15th Street."
